These scholarships are awarded by the Mount St. Clare Charitable Education Trust, Clinton National Bank, Trustee. There are several requirements you will need to meet for your application to be considered for a scholarship award. You must:

- Have graduated or will graduate from a high school located in either Clinton County Iowa or Whiteside County Illinois
- Either currently attend or will attend a 2 or 4 year university of college within the State of Iowa
- Preference will be given, but is not required, for those meeting the above requirements and attending a Catholic post-secondary institution or attending a community college located in Clinton County Iowa
- Awards will be made on an annual basis only. Recipients may re-apply for subsequent years. No awards will be made for more than one year at a time.

You must complete the attached application form and return the application prior to the due date. Applications received or postmarked after the due date will <u>not</u> be considered. Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be considered for a scholarship award.

You **must** provide a copy of your letter of acceptance if you have not yet started post-secondary classes or a copy of a current college transcript if you have taken post-secondary classes.

You must indicate which scholarships you wish to apply for, listed on the attached application form. If additional requirements for individual scholarships are listed, please provide that information. If the additional requirements include a showing of financial need, submit a copy of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FSFSA) with this application.

All information provided will be confidential, shared with members of a scholarship selection committee appointed by the trustee, and retained by the trustee for regulatory compliance purposes.

Any and all scholarships shall be paid to the post-secondary institution you attend for further credit to your student account. Some scholarships may be granted to multiple recipients from the available scholarship amount each year. Payment is anticipated to be made in October. Should you decide not to continue your education, for any reason, any excess funds awarded are to be returned to the trustee.
